Competition Rules:

- ❖ School teams must follow NFHS Rules
- ❖ All-Star teams must follow USASF Rules.
- ❖ School cheer teams have a routine time limit of 2 minutes 30 seconds with 1 minute 30 seconds for music.
- ❖ All-star cheer teams have a routine time limit of 2 minutes 30 seconds and may incorporate all music.
- ❖ Individual cheer routines have a time limit of 1 minute 30 seconds with 1 minute for music.
- ❖ Stunt group routines have a time limit of 1 minute 30 seconds and must be performed to music.
- ❖ Cheer dance division routines have a time limit of 2 minutes.
- ❖ Dance teams (categories – pom, jazz, kick, and hip hop) have a routine time limit of 2 minutes and 30 seconds.
- ❖ Individual and ensemble dance routines are limited to 1 minute and 30 seconds.
- ❖ Divisions with less than 3 schools competing may be bumped to another division.
- ❖ Score sheets and trophies will not be mailed and must be picked up by a team representative.

“Pay It Forward” Scholarship Opportunity:

- ❖ Four Scholarships Total: Two Cheer Scholarships & Two Dance Scholarships, each worth \$250 towards college!
- ❖ Who is eligible? High School Seniors who plan to attend college are eligible for the scholarship.
- ❖ High School Seniors must submit a short essay (one page or less) telling the judges how they plan to use their college education to help “Pay It Forward” to society. Applicants must also compete in the individual routine competition.
